DETAILED INFORMATION

I. Eligibility to apply for the posts:

1. The applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. He/she must be medically fit both in mind and in body-a certificate duly signed by the District Medical Officer, Nagaon District or any competent Registered Medical Officer, approved by the Vice-Chancellor, shall have to be produced by any person who would be appointed as a Teacher, before/she is allowed to join.
3. A certificate about good character from the Head of the Institution last attended or served shall accompany an application for any post of a Teacher.
4. The candidate must possess the minimum qualifications for the post.
5. Upper age limit of the candidates shall be as per the Govt. of Assam rules / norms.
6. The prescribed application shall be issued from **25th May, 2017** from (I) the **Office of the Registrar of the University, or (II)** downloading from the University website.(www.mssv.co.in) The price of the application form is Rs 2,000/- (for post no 1to 5) and Rs 1,000/- (**for post no 6 and 7**) to be paid either by cash or demand draft drawn in favour of "**MAHAPURUSHA SRIMANTA SANKARADEVA VISWAVIDYALAYA, NAGAON**" payable at **STATE BANK OF INDIA, NAGAON MAIN BRANCH**.
7. Last date of receipt of filled up application is 12th June, 2017
8. Only short-listed candidates shall be called for interview. Canvassing directly or indirectly shall disqualify a candidate.

II. General Qualification, Experience and Requirements:

1. Assistant Professor: Minimum qualification and experience:

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% marks in Master Degree (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the subject concerned.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidates must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SET.

- iii. NET/SET shall not be required for such Master Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SET is not conducted

2. Associate Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph. D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the subject concerned.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures

- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research papers, in the subject concerned.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum 300 score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS) set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers. The candidate should submit a draft of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) prepared by himself or herself.

3. Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (a) (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score 400 as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers. The candidate should submit a draft of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) prepared by himself or herself

OR

- (b) An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

Age: Upper age limit of the candidates shall be as per the Govt. of Assam rules / norms

N.B. Retired Professors/Associate Professors upto the age of 63 years can also apply for the post of Professors.

4. Deputy Registrar : Minimum Qualification and Experience:

Essential:

- i. A master degree with at least 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the seven point scale
- ii. At least 9 years of experience as Assistant Professor along with experience in educational administrations.

Or

Comparable experience in a research establishment and/or other institutions of higher education

Or

5 years of administrative experience as Assistant Registrar in educational institutions or an equivalent rank.

Desirable

- I. Good command over both English and Assamese, good organizational skills, basic knowledge of examination procedures in college/university levels
- II. Good knowledge of Computer Application

Age limit: Below 45 years

Pay scale: Pay band of Rs. **12000/- to Rs. 40,000/-**, + G.P. Rs. 6,300/-p.m.

5. Assistant Registrar (Administration) Minimum Qualification and Experience

Essential:

- i. A master degree with at least 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade of B in the seven point scale

Or

5 years of administrative experience in educational institutions or an equivalent rank.

Desirable

- i. Good command over both English and Assamese, good organizational skills, basic knowledge of examination procedures in college/university levels
- ii. Good knowledge of Computer Application

Age limit: Below 38 years

Pay scale: Pay band of Rs. **12000/- to Rs. 40,000/-**, + G.P. Rs. 6,100/-p.m.

6. LIBRARY ASSISTANT (TECHNICAL) Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- i. Bachelor of Library Science
- ii. Good knowledge of Computer Application and basic knowledge of library management software packages
- iii. Age as per the State Govt. Assam

Salary: Rs 15,000/-Consolidated

7. Laboratory Assistant (Computer)

- i. Graduate in any discipline with good academic record.
- ii. Diploma/degree in Computer Application
- iii. Age as per the State Govt. Assam

Salary: Rs 15,000/-Consolidated

The University reserves the right to select candidates for appointment to the above mentioned posts on the basis of its immediate requirements.

(III) Conditions to be fulfilled after appointment:

1. A person appointed to the post of a Teacher or Officer shall join **within one month from the date of issue of appointment order**, failing which the appointment order is liable to be cancelled, provided that in exceptional circumstances, the Vice-Chancellor may extend this period.
2. Before a person appointed to the post of a Teacher or Officer joins in his/her post, he/she shall execute an agreement with the university that he/she shall strictly abide by the provisions of the Acts and the Ordinances. A Teacher shall also undertake in the agreement to submit to the Vice-Chancellor a self-appraisal report of his/her performance annually.
3. The person, after joining the post of Teacher, will be subjected to the provisions of the MSSV Teachers' Service Conditions Ordinance and Officer to the provisions of MSSV Employees' Service Conditions Ordinance, etc.
