Paper II for Ph.D. Candidates of Sankaradeva Studies and Ph.D. candidates of Assamese.

**Paper I: 100 marks (Objective type)**

Questions to test General Knowledge and aptitude in the subjects History, Geography, Literature, Language, Culture, Logical Reasoning and Current Affairs-Regional, National & International

**Paper II: Sankaradeva Studies (Subject concerned): 100 Marks**

20 marks for objective type questions and 80 marks for theoretical and descriptive questions.

**Paper II: Assamese (Subject concerned): 100 Marks**

20 marks for objective type questions and 80 marks for theoretical and descriptive questions.

Candidates shall have to obtain at least 50% marks (45% for Reserved category candidates) in each paper.

For the candidates to pursue research in Sankaradeva Studies the medium of both questions and answers shall be English.

**Medium:**

**Paper-I** : Questions and answers in English for both Sankaradeva Studies and Assamese.

**Paper-II** : (A) English for Sankaradeva Studies, and  
(B) Assamese for Assamese Programme

**Note: Those candidates who have not submitted required documents like NOC, Certificates, etc. must submit on the day of the Entrance Test.**
