DETAILED INFORMATION

I. Eligibility to apply for the posts:

1. The applicant must be a citizen of India.
2. He/she must be medically fit both in mind and in body-a certificate duly signed by the District Medical Officer, Nagaon District or any competent Registered Medical Officer, approved by the Vice-Chancellor, shall have to be produced by any person who would be appointed as a Teacher, before/she is allowed to join.
3. A certificate about good character from the Head of the Institution last attended or served shall accompany an application for any post of a Teacher.
4. The candidate must possess the minimum qualifications for the post.
5. Upper age limit of the candidates shall be as per the Govt. of Assam rules / norms.
6. The prescribed application shall be issued from **1st June, 2016** from (I) the **Office of the Registrar of the University, or (II)** downloading from the University website.(www.mssv.co.in) The price of the application form is Rs 2,000/- to be paid either by cash or demand draft drawn in favour of "**MAHAPURUSHA SRIMANTA SANKARADEVA VISWAVIDYALAYA, NAGAON**" payable at **STATE BANK OF INDIA, NAGAON MAIN BRANCH.**
7. Last date of submission of filled up application is **10th June, 2016**
8. Only short-listed candidates shall be called for interview. Canvassing directly or indirectly shall disqualify a candidate.

II. General Qualification, Experience and Requirements:

1. Assistant Professor: Minimum qualification and experience:

- (i) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or Ph.D. Degree (under new regulation)

2. Associate Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (i) Good academic record with a Ph. D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- (ii) A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- (iii) A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research papers, in the subject concerned.
- (iv) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- (v) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of

minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers. The candidate should submit a draft of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) prepared by himself or herself.

3. Professor: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- (a) (i) An eminent scholar with Ph.D. in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as per the Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC's revised Regulation of minimum qualifications for appointment of teachers. The candidate should submit a draft of the Academic Performance Indicator (API) prepared by himself or herself

OR

- (b) An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.

Age: Upper age limit of the candidates shall be as per the Govt. of Assam rules / norms

N.B. Retired Professors/Associate Professors upto the age of 63 years can also apply for the post of Professors.

4. ASSISTANT CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS: Minimum Qualification and Experience:

Essential:

Uniform good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University

Desirable

- I. Good command over both English and Assamese, good organizational skills, basic knowledge of examination procedures in college/university levels
- II. Good knowledge of Computer Application

Age limit: Below 45 years

Pay scale: Pay band of Rs. 12000/- to Rs. 40,000/-, + G.P. Rs. 5,400/-p.m.

5. LIBRARY ASSISTANT (TECHNICAL) Minimum Qualification and Experience:

- i. Bachelor of Library Science
- ii. Good knowledge of Computer Application and basic knowledge of library management software packages
- Salary: Rs 15,000/-Consolidated

The University reserves the right to select candidates for appointment to the above mentioned posts on the basis of its immediate requirements.

(III) Conditions to be fulfilled after appointment:

1. A person appointed to the post of a Teacher or Officer shall join **within one month from the date of issue of appointment order**, failing which the appointment order is liable to be cancelled, provided that in exceptional circumstances, the Vice-Chancellor may extend this period.
2. Before a person appointed to the post of a Teacher or Officer joins in his/her post, he/she shall execute an agreement with the university that he/she shall strictly abide by the provisions of the Acts and the Ordinances. A Teacher shall also undertake in the agreement to submit to the Vice-Chancellor a self-appraisal report of his/her performance annually.
3. The person, after joining the post of Teacher, will be subjected to the provisions of the MSSV Teachers' Service Conditions Ordinance and Officer to be provisions of MSSV Employees' Service Conditions Ordinance, etc.
