**MAHAPURUSHA SRIMANTA SANKARADEVA VISWAVIDYALAYA RULES FOR
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE MSSV STUDENT AID FUND (MSSVSAF) TO
THE DESERVING STUDENTS OF ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD FAMILIES**

1. General:

MSSVSAF is a provision for giving financial assistance to the deserving students hailing from economically backward families but with good academic records.

2. Eligibility:

- i. Financial assistance shall be considered to be given to the regular fulltime graduate/post graduate students of this University hailing from economically backward families.
- ii. Annual income of the applicant's family shall not exceed Rs. 1,20,000/- (One lakh Twenty Thousand only).
- iii. The student shall have to score at least 55 percentage of marks in the last semester examination.
- iv. The applicant shall have at least 85% of attendance in the last semester.
- v. The applicant shall not be a recipient of any other scholarship.

3. Selection procedure:

- I. The Head of the Department concern shall scrutinize the applications regarding fulfillment of the eligibility norms. He/she shall also discuss the cases of the applicants with other faculty members of the Department and shall decide the priority of the applicants in terms academic achievements and financial condition of the applicant's family.
- II. The Head of the Department shall send the list of the deserving applicants (showing priority) along with his/her recommendation to the Registrar, MSSV for further action.
- III. The Registrar, MSSV shall place the recommendations received from the Departments before a Committee on MSSVSAF to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor, MSSV.
- IV. The Committee on MSSVSAF shall consider the recommendations received from the Head of the Departments and select the beneficiaries.
- V. The decision of the Committee on MSSVSAF shall be final.
